



Marc Tocci, Class of 1999

Marc Tocci was a standout three-sport athlete at Westford Academy, excelling in football, basketball, and was Captain of the baseball team. Marc was known for his physical presence and competitive drive in all three sports.

On February 17, 1999 (his 18th birthday), Marc became Westford Academy's first boys' player to reach the 1,000 point milestone with his 20th point in a 67-64 victory over Weston High School. Marc also added 11 rebounds, 4 assists and a game winning free-throw in his well-balanced effort that night. He would hold the scoring record for the next three years. Marc is also 3rd in career assists and 2nd in career free throws made. He helped lead his team to a 21-2 record, a DCL Championship (undefeated in league play) and a MIAA Division Two North Final at the Tsongas Arena. Marc was also named both a Lowell Sun and DCL All-Star. Marc was a standout basketball player at Westford Academy.

Marc was offered a football scholarship at Fordham University, but a career ending injury eliminated that opportunity. Marc then attended and graduated from UMass Amherst.
